- **E-911 Emergency Access** – Preliminary discussions with CAMA offer the ability to install a third E-911 emergency access on south beach centrally located between the two existing accesses (Sandpiper Trail & Loggerhead). This provide a quicker response time to emergencies on south beach that may occur between Mourning Warbler Trail down to Brown Pelican Trail. Staff will look to discuss with the Public Safety Committee at its next meeting for comment/feedback. The exact location of this new access will be located off SBHW adjacent to existing access boardwalk # 24A & 24B between Silversides Trail and Peppervine Trail.
- **Brunswick County Register of Deeds/U.S. Passport** – BC Register of Deeds, who is the only agency authorized to accept U.S. Passport applications in Brunswick County, will be providing an outreach program for citizens to apply for and submit their application for a passport. County ROD staff will be setting up at the Southport Community Building (223 East Bay Street) on September 8<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. to accept applications. This information will be made available at the Council Meeting in August.
