

VILLAGE OF BALD HEAD ISLAND
PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY
Amended

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. Chapters 160A, 166A, and 14 as well as Chapter 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances authorize the Village of Bald Head Island (“Village”) to declare the existence of a State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Chapter 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances, the Mayor or his designee is authorized to proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and to declare orders for evacuation, curfew, and various other restrictions and prohibitions; and

WHEREAS, an imminently approaching hurricane poses imminent risk to the life, safety, health, and welfare of the residents and non-residents within the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Mayor or his designee by Chapter 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances, the undersigned Mayor or his designee does hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and further hereby imposes the following orders, prohibitions, and restrictions:

1. **EVACUATION**. Per Governor Cooper’s Mandatory Evacuation of September 3, 2019, the Mayor hereby orders a **Mandatory** evacuation of all persons of the Village effective September 4, 2019 at 8:00AM. Any individual to whom this section applies, who is located within the Village, is hereby ordered to evacuate the Village by means of ferry transportation to the mainland. Such ferries shall commence transportation of individuals from the Village immediately. All are advised that the ferry shall continue to operate so long as the weather permits the safe operation thereof. Early evacuation of the Village is important as the availability of such transportation becomes more tenuous as time passes. Everyone is further advised that Emergency Services, during the normally available for protection of life and property, may not be available at some or all times during the State of Emergency.

2. **CURFEW**. There is no curfew associated with this amendment as this is a mandatory evacuation order.

3. **RESTRICTIONS ON POSSESSION, CONSUMPTION, OR TRANSFER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**. There shall be no selling of, transfer of or consumption of alcoholic beverages in licensed establishments until the State of Emergency is in effect.

4. **RESTRICTIONS ON POSSESSION, TRANSPORTATION, AND TRANSFER OF DANGEROUS WEAPONS**. The transportation, sale or purchase of any dangerous weapon or substance as defined in Village Ordinance Section 8-36(b) is prohibited while the State of Emergency is in effect. Further, the possession of any such dangerous weapon or substance off the premises owned by the individuals possessing such dangerous weapons or substances is prohibited while the State of Emergency is in effect.

5. **PRICE GOUGING.** Pursuant to this Proclamation, N.C.G.S. Sections 75-38 and 14-288.12, and Section 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances, price gouging is expressly forbidden. Violators are subject to criminal prosecution.

Any violations of the above amended Proclamation is a violation of Village Ordinances and is punishable by a \$50 fine per occurrence or a under a state citation to include a Class 2 Misdemeanor.
