

**Chapter 28, Transportation and Vehicles  
Summary of Proposed Changes (8/16/2019)**

<b>Proposed</b>	<b>Current</b>
<b><u>Internal Combustion Engine (ICE) and Commercial-Use Vehicles</u></b>	
Changes work day hours for ICE vehicles from 6 a.m. – 6 p.m., Monday through Friday; and adds Labor Day, Thanksgiving Friday and Christmas Eve to ICE vehicle holiday (same as barge holidays) except for Special Use Permit holders	Monday-Friday 6 am-sunset; Fewer holidays than barge schedule; no weekend ICE limitations except for “construction equipment vehicles” and “construction delivery vehicles”
Limits ICE vehicle use on weekends to trams, Public Safety, Public Works, Village, Utilities , unless Special Use Permit obtained	Limits “construction equipment vehicles” and “construction delivery vehicles” only
Differentiation between short-visit ICE vehicles i.e. delivery vehicles, moving vans, etc. vs ICE vehicles that “live” on BHI	No differentiation
Different allowable dimensions for daily and short term ICE vehicles versus those that “live” on BHI; (“island” ICE vehicles size limits comparable to transit vans and small pick-up trucks except for Special Use Permit vehicles)	No limits
Restricts use of ICE-vehicle through-traffic on Edward Teach Wynd	Listed in different ordinance
Promotes use of golf carts/electrics for commercial use where possible with incentive of allowable 24/7/365 road use AND avoiding ICE fees	No incentives in place
Includes a plan for transition of compliance and a grandfather period of not to exceed five years for vehicles with a valid annual permit at the time of ordinance adoption.	No transition of compliance plan for ICE vehicles
Sets maximum trailer width	None
*ICE fees increased to accommodate COLA (Fees part of Village budget process)	No change in ICE fees since 2000
No gas-powered golf carts	Gas-powered carts allowed for commercial use approved in lieu of ICE vehicle on occasion
<b><u>Personal-Use Vehicles</u></b>	
Language broadened to allow electric vehicles as opposed to golf carts	No specification or limitation
Limits on length, width, horsepower of golf-carts and electric vehicles	Limits for golf carts & electrics in current ordinance
Golf cart lift kits limited in height to 4 inches; Lift kits also have tire and springs requirements	No specifications
ATVs, jet skis and similarly gas-powered vehicles limited to Conservancy, Village/Utilities and BHI Club	Few limits
No electric devices when human-powered exist (scooters; skateboards, Segways, etc.)	Electric devices allowed for licensed/provisional drivers; helmets required
Increases and clarifies penalties; adds more and/or clarifies violations	Fines/penalties and violations have had few changes and are often difficult to find in existing ordinance
