**MANDATORY EVACUATION**

**EFFECTIVE: SEPTEMBER 10, 2018**

The Village of Bald Head Island recognizes that Hurricane Florence poses a threat to the Island and is therefore ordering a **MANDATORY EVACUATION** of residents to begin at **6:00 PM Monday, September 10, 2018.**

Village ordinance requires you to depart the Island no later than 9:30 AM Ferry on Wednesday, September 12, 2018.

Ferry service will be interrupted due to Hurricane Florence for an extended period of time. For up-to-date information regarding ferry services please contact Deep Point Ferry Depot at [www.baldheadislandferry.com](http://www.baldheadislandferry.com).

**REMINDER**

Water Service will be turned off effective 9:00AM, September 12, 2018, and will remain off for the duration of the weather event.

There will be no Public Safety services available for the duration of the storm and until such time that the river is re-opened.
