## **System Pressure Advisory!**

The entire Village of Bald Head Island “residential and non-residential” water customers have been placed under a system pressure advisory today July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2018.

This advisory is due to a split 8” water supply line located at the Caswell Beach area. The supply line is owned and maintained by Brunswick County Utilities. The repair is scheduled to start this afternoon around 3:00PM and should be repaired in two to three hours.

**Please understand...** Bald Head Island will not experience any disruption in water service. We are under this pressure advisory because we purchase water from Brunswick County Utilities that is supplied by this 8” line. Therefore, as a precaution we are required to advise the following:

Periods of no flow or low water pressure in the distribution system increases the potential for back siphonage and can introduce bacteria into the water system. As a safety precaution, water samples will be sent to the local laboratory for microbiological analysis, this analysis requires an incubation period and therefore results will not be known for 24 to 48 hours.

The NC Division of Water Resources advises that when water is restored consumers boil all water used for human consumption (including drinking, cooking, brushing teeth and making ice) or use bottled water.

Vigorous boiling for five (5) minute should kill any disease-causing organisms that may be present in the water.

This office is strongly urging the water consumers to conserve water whenever possible.

This advisory shall begin when water outage occurs and remain in effect until further written notification is issued.
