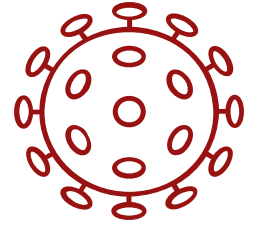


COVID-19 GUIDANCE for BHI Renters



SYMPTOMS

According to the CDC, the following symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the COVID-19 virus*:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

*This list does not include all possible symptoms. CDC will continue to update this list as they learn more about COVID-19.

**IF YOU NEED IMMEDIATE CARE
CALL 911**

If you do not need immediate care:

STEP 1:

Call your primary physician at home and see if telehealth options are available.

STEP 2:

If telehealth options are not available, **call 911** and tell the operator you are on Bald Head Island.

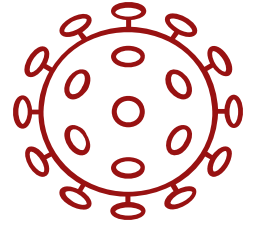

When traveling to BHI during the pandemic please note:

- Masks/face coverings are required on the ferries, trams, and in the Island Package Center & Post Office.
- The Island Package Center (IPC) is working on reduced/staggered schedules to protect staff & limit access to the public. To further protect staff and our customers, the Village is asking all customers to minimize shipping to the IPC. Island residents have been asked to limit shipping to only essentials such as medicine.

COVID-19 HEALTH TIPS @NCDHHS	 <p>Wash hands with soap and water for 20+ seconds each time.</p>	 <p>Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.</p>
	 <p>Stay home - especially when sick.</p>	 <p>Avoid close contact with people who are ill.</p>
	 <p>Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.</p>	 <p>Throw away tissues after coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose.</p>
