Proclamation of State of Emergency – Second Amendment

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) pandemic, the Village of Bald Head Island, North Carolina proclaimed a State of Emergency on March 19, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Village issued a First Amendment to its State of Emergency Proclamation on March 30, 2020 which restricted certain construction activities as set forth in Section 2 of the First Amendment (the “Construction Restrictions”); and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined it necessary to extend the expiration time of the Construction Restrictions to reduce the impacts of COVID-19 and in the interest of public health, safety and good order.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in the Mayor by Chapters 160A, 166A and 14 of the North Carolina General Statutes, as well as Chapter 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances, I, J. Andrew Sayre, Mayor of the Village of Bald Head Island, do hereby proclaim and impose the following orders, prohibitions and restrictions:

- 1) **Prior Proclamation:** The Village’s Proclamation of State of Emergency of March 19, 2020 is ratified, reaffirmed and shall continue in full force and effect.
- 2) **Construction Restrictions:** The Construction Restrictions shall expire at 5:30 A.M. on Monday, April 20, 2020.
- 3) **Emergency Area:** The emergency area covered by this State of Emergency shall be the Village’s entire corporation jurisdiction.


This Proclamation is effective upon signature.
