



## **VILLAGE OF BALD HEAD ISLAND PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, N.C.G.S. Chapters 160A, 166A, and 14 as well as Chapter 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances authorize the Village of Bald Head Island (“Village”) to declare the existence of a State of Emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Chapter 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances, the Mayor or his designee is authorized to proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and to declare orders for evacuation, curfew, and various other restrictions and prohibitions; and

**WHEREAS**, Hurricane Isaias, which is currently approaching the Eastern seaboard and is projected to affect the North Carolina coast by Monday, August 3, 2020, poses imminent risk to the life, safety, health, and welfare of the residents and non-residents within the Village;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Executive Order No. 154, on July 31, 2020, Governor Roy Cooper declared a statewide State of Emergency for Hurricane Isaias;

**WHEREAS**, capacity of the Bald Head Island Ferry to and from Bald Head Island is limited to fifty percent (50%) due to the COVID-19 Pandemic:

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council of the Village of Bald Head Island wishes to preserve the capacity of the passenger ferries to evacuate those persons who choose to do so;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED**, by the authority vested in the Mayor or his designee by Chapter 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances, the undersigned Mayor or his designee does hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and further hereby imposes the following orders, prohibitions, and restrictions:

1. **EVACUATION**. Not Applicable at this time but subject to change.
2. **CURFEW**. The curfew details will be announced tomorrow, August 2, 2020.
3. **ACCESS LIMITED**. Persons who do not have plans/arrangements for overnight or longer lodging, other than contractors and regularly employees of on-Island businesses, shall be prohibited from arriving at Bald Head Island (i.e., daytrips for recreational purposes are prohibited until such time as this Proclamation is rescinded).
4. **RESTRICTIONS ON POSSESSION, CONSUMPTION, OR TRANSFER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**. Not applicable at this time but subject to change.

**5. RESTRICTIONS ON POSSESSION, TRANSPORTATION, AND TRANSFER OF DANGEROUS WEAPONS.** Not applicable at this time but subject to change.

**6. PRICE GOUGING.** Pursuant to this Proclamation, N.C.G.S. Sections 75-38 and 14-288.12, and Section 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances, price gouging is expressly forbidden. Violators are subject to criminal prosecution.

**7. RE-ENTRY OF VILLAGE.** Not applicable at this time but subject to change.
