



A public hearing was held on August 20, 2021, in the Multipurpose Room of the Department of Public Safety Building Located at 273 Edward Teach Extension, Bald Head Island, North Carolina on the Village's bond order authorizing the issuance of \$54,000,000 public transportation bonds.

Below is an excerpt of from the minutes of the August 20, 2021, public hearing:

Councilor Hill moved that the Village Council proceed to hold a public hearing on the bond order. The motion was seconded by Councilor Gardner and was unanimously adopted.

At 10:19 a.m., the Mayor announced that the Village Council would hear anyone who wished to be heard on the questions of the validity of the bond order and the advisability of issuing the bonds.

The Village Council heard from the following citizens, all of whom spoke against the approval of the bond order:

After the Village Council had heard all persons who requested to be heard, Councilor Gardner moved that the public hearing be closed. The motion was seconded by Councilor Hill and was unanimously adopted.
