Tip of the Week

SIX FIRE SAFETY TIPS



1. Install and Test Smoke Detectors Regularly

Install a smoke alarm on every level of the home and outside sleeping areas. Smoke alarms should be tested every month, and batteries changed annually.

2. Develop a Fire Escape Plan

Designate a safe, accessible meeting spot outside, away from your home. A fire escape plan should be devised and practiced at least twice a year.



3. Stop, Drop and Roll

Stop, drop to the ground and roll if your clothes are on fire. Families should know this technique and it should be practiced with children.



4. Assemble an Emergency Supply Kit

Make an emergency supply kit and include things like a flashlight, batteries, a whistle, blankets and water. An extra supply kit should be kept in a car in case you are unable to immediately return inside.



5. Gather Emergency Contact Information

Maintain a list of emergency contact numbers in cell phones and keep it in the supply kit.



6. Store Important Documents in a Safe Place

Find a safe place to store important documents like birth certificates and financial information. You should even consider making copies of these documents and storing them in a secure, off-site location.

Suspicious activity is an occurrence that is out of place in your neighborhood. Factors such as race, ethnicity, national origin, or religious affiliation alone are not suspicious. The public should report only suspicious behavior and situations rather than beliefs, thoughts, ideas or expressions.

RECOGNIZE



- An unsolicited call from a government agency or big company
- Threats of harm if you don't provide personal or financial info
- Product or travel offers that sound too good to be true

RESPOND

- **DON'T** answer calls from unknown numbers
- **DON'T** provide sensitive data to unknown callers
- **DON'T** follow instructions like "Press 1 to get off the call list"

TEN TIPS FOR FIRE SAFETY

1 Install smoke alarms on every level of your home, inside bedrooms and outside sleeping areas.



2 Test smoke alarms monthly. Replace batteries at least once a year.

3 Have a family fire escape plan and practice the plan twice a year.

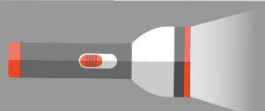


4 If there's a fire in your home, get out, dial 911 and don't go back inside.

5 Keep matches and lighters out of children's reach



6 Use flashlights during power outages, not candles.



7 Never leave a burning candle unattended.



8 Turn off space heaters when you leave the room and don't leave them unattended.



9 Only use smoking materials outside.



10 Keep flammable items away from anything that can get hot, such as space heaters.

FIRE Kills

THE KITCHEN: AN UNLIKELY DANGER ZONE

Never leave your cooking unattended. Always keep your stove company. Especially if you're frying something—that's when things can cross the line in mere seconds. It's one of the simplest fire safety tips, but it's also the leading cause of kitchen fires.

Keep it clean. Keep stove and counter surfaces free of clutter, grease, and especially flammable objects like hairspray, bug spray, or air freshener. In case of an emergency you'll be able to react faster given the freedom of space.

Set a timer. Don't just rely on your brain; we're human, and we get distracted. A timer can remind you to switch off the burner or oven, saving your food and possibly your house from being burnt.

Wear tight clothes. Billowing sleeves or hanging accessories above a lit stove can spell disaster.

Install a smoke detector in the kitchen. In a commercial environment, consider investing in fire safety training for employees.

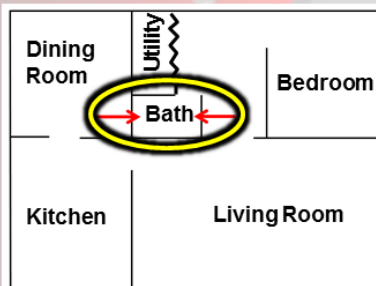

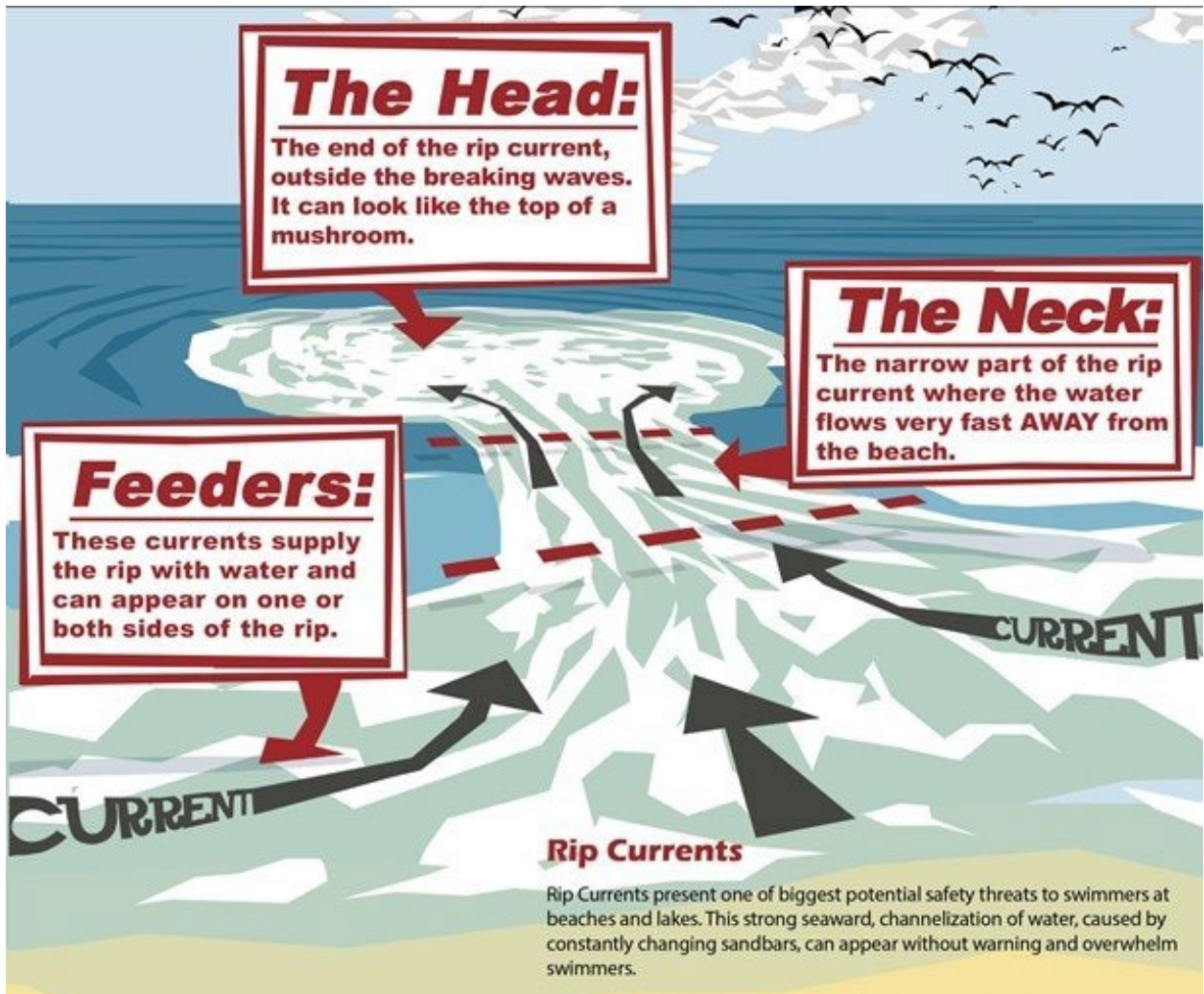

Tip of the Week



The aftermath of disasters can bring out the best in people - often with expressions of financial support and volunteerism. Unfortunately, these events also provide opportunities for fraudsters to prey on individuals who have been affected or those who wish to show their support through donations.

Please use caution if you encounter any of the red flags listed below, particularly when the contact is unsolicited or you do not recognize the contact:

Government Disaster Assistance Organizations

- **Unsolicited calls asking for financial account information:** Officials with government disaster assistance agencies, such as FEMA or the Small Business Administration (SBA), will never call or text requesting personal or financial account information.
- **Fees associated with applications for disaster relief payments:** There are no fees to apply for or receive disaster assistance from FEMA or the Small Business Administration.

Post-Disaster Insurance Scams

- **Unsolicited calls or visits from contractors and home improvement companies:** After disasters, fraudsters may pose as contractors or representatives for home improvement companies that partner with insurance companies. If you are contacted by someone matching this description, never give them your policy numbers, coverage details, or personal information without first verifying their identity.

Disaster Relief Charity Scams

- **Fake charities:** Fraudsters can create fake charities to solicit funds during and after natural disasters. Always check the legitimacy of the charity through their official website or visit the National Association of State Charity Officials at <https://www.nasconet.org/>

Common signs of fraud:

- **Sense of urgency:** Fraudsters often require immediate action to avoid negative impacts. Before providing any information, contact the company or agency they represent through a more secure or verified method.
- **Request for personal/financial information:** Fraudsters want to gather more information on their potential victims, such as address, social security numbers, account numbers, insurance policies or PINs. Never provide information to an unsolicited contact. Instead, contact the company or agency they represent through a more secure or verified method.
- **Grammatical errors:** Fraud-related communications often contain grammatical errors such as using a word incorrectly, using the wrong tense, misspelled words, or missing/incorrect punctuation.
- **Links:** Never click on a link in a suspicious email or text message. These links can download malicious software or viruses to your device or redirect you to a fake website. Either can lead to personal and financial information being compromised.
