NOTICE OF BOND REFERENDUM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a bond referendum will be held in the Village of Bald Head Island, North Carolina (the “Village”), on March 5, 2024, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the Village and to the qualified voters of the Village’s Integrated Shoreline Municipal Service District (Zones A and B) the question of whether to approve or disapprove not to exceed \$13,500,000 Beach Improvement Bonds of the Village, which indebtedness shall be secured by a pledge of the Village’s faith and credit. The proceeds of such bonds would be used to pay capital costs of providing beach improvements, including replacement of a groin field and transporting and providing additional sand and sand dunes, all for the control of beach erosion and flood and hurricane protection. If such bonds are issued, taxes will or may be levied (including, if legally authorized, taxes within the Village’s Integrated Shoreline Municipal Service District (Zones A and B)) for the payment thereof.

The bond referendum will be conducted by the Brunswick County Board of Elections (the “Board of Elections”). Except for certain situations, the last day to register to vote in the bond referendum is February 9, 2024.
