

# OPERATION RE-FOREST – WE FOREST STATISTICS

## Operation Re-Forest-We Forest Statistics – (5<sup>th</sup> Annual)

- 6 live oak trees were planted in BHA Common Area as Honor Trees.
- 60 trees were planted by BHA or delivered to owners. This included 22 live oaks, 20 yaupon hollies, and 18 wax myrtles.

## Operation Re-Forest-We Forest Statistics (4<sup>th</sup> Annual)

- Volunteers planted 27 live oak trees and 6 wax myrtles.
- Property owners planted 25 live oaks, 35 wax myrtles, 19 yaupon hollies, and 15 sabal minor palms.

## Operation Re-Forest-We Forest Statistics (3rd Annual)

- 56 total trees were planted. 10 were Honor Trees and there were numerous shrubs. Many were live oaks.

## Operation Re-Forest-We Forest Statistics (2nd Annual)

- 81 live oaks, 18 yaupon holly, 15 wax myrtle, 11 American holly, 7 magnolia, and 2 beautyberry.

## Operation Re-Forest-We Forest Statistics (1<sup>st</sup> Annual)

- Volunteers planted a total of 167 trees.
- BHA worked with 26 property owners to plant up to 70 additional trees.
- Other property owners planted 61 trees of their own.
