



System Pressure Advisory!

The water consumers of Village of Bald Head Island Utilities, in Brunswick County will experience a period of low pressure in the distribution system at the following location(s): Harbour Village from Marina Park to Row Boat Row. This is expected to begin at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 6, 2025, and last approximately one hour or less.

Periods of low or no pressure in the distribution system increase the potential for back siphonage and introduction of bacteria into the water system.

Therefore, when water service is restored, consumers are advised to **boil all water** used for human consumption (including drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes and food preparation) or use bottled water.

Vigorous boiling for one (1) minute should kill any disease-causing organisms that may be present in the water.

Water customers are strongly urged to conserve water whenever possible. This advisory remains in effect until further written notification is issued.
