



COMMERCIAL USE TRAILERS

New size requirements effective July 1, 2026

No commercial-use trailer shall be permitted or approved for use on village streets if the box's overall width exceeds six feet, or seven feet if it is a deck-over trailer and the overall length exceeds 16 feet.

The trailer tongue is NOT considered in the size - box only.



Disaster Exception:

Trailers that exceed maximum allowable dimensions may be permitted by a daily permit when a state of emergency proclamation is declared by the mayor for a natural disaster event and approved by the public safety department chief and may be extended for a reasonable time after the state of emergency is rescinded.



Heavy Equipment:

Trailers that have heavy equipment permanently attached or trailers that are used in the transport of heavy equipment, may be eligible for a Special Use Permit. These permits are issued through the Department of Public Safety.

Oversized trailers on the island after July 1 will be subject to penalties including fines, towing, impoundment, or removal.



TRUCKS

Updated Size Requirements and Restrictions

All annual permit holders as of September 2025 have until July 1, 2027 to come into compliance with these new size requirements unless the exceptions below apply:

<u>Maximum Allowable Dimensions</u>	<u>Length</u>	<u>Width</u>	<u>Height</u>
(a) Pick-up Trucks & Cargo Vans:	230 inches	82 inches	
(b) Box Trucks (Delivery Use):	28 feet box	102 inches	13 feet
(c) Box Truck (Contractor Use):	16 feet box	96 inches	13 feet

Exceptions:

1) Commercial vehicles that exceed maximum allowable length dimensions may be eligible for an annual permit limited to one (1) pickup truck registered to a person or entity possessing a NC General Contractor's license and in the discretion of the Public Safety Department Chief.

2) A Special Use Permit may be issued by the Public Safety Department Chief if the need is justified.

For the full-size trucks, only short regular cabs fall under 18 feet

Category 3: Equal to or greater than 18 feet but less than 21 feet

Ford - Ranger Crew Cab/Long bed, F-250/F-350 Super Duty SuperCab/Crew Cab, Ford F-150 SuperCab/Supercrew.

Chevrolet - Silverado 2500HD/3500HD Double Cab Standard Bed/Crew Cab Standard Bed, Silverado 1500 Double Cab Standard Bed/Crew Cab Short Bed

GMC - Sierra 2500HD/3500 HD Double Cab Standard Bed/Crew Cab Standard Bed, GMC Sierra 1500 Double Cab Standard Bed/Crew Cab Short Bed

Nissan - Frontier long bed, Titan Crew Cab Short Bed,

Ram - 2500/3500 Crew Cab 6'4" bed, 1500 Crew Cab 5'7" bed/Quad cab 6'4" bed

Toyota - Tacoma Double Cab Long Bed, Tundra Double Cab Short Bed/CrewMax Short Bed

These are 21 feet or over:

- F-150, Silverado, Sierra Long-bed Crew Cabs
- Ford Super Duty 8-ft bed Crew Cab
- Ram 2500/3500 Mega Cab
- Toyota Tundra CrewMax Long Bed (≈22 ft)
